Creating

1 Generate and Conceptualize Artistic Ideas and Work PK.MU:CR1

- 1 The creative ideas, concepts, and feelings that influence musicians' work emerge from a variety of sources. PK.MU:CR1.1

- 2 Musicians' presentation of creative work is the culmination of a process of creation and communication. PK.MU:CR3.2

- 1 Performers' interest in and knowledge of musical works, understanding of their own technical skill, and the context for a performance influence the selection of repertoire. PK.MU:PR4.1

- 2 Analyzing creators' context and how they manipulate elements of music provides insight into their intent and informs performance. PK.MU:PR4.2

- 1 Musicians judge performance based on criteria that vary across time, place, and cultures. The context and how a work is presented influence audience response. **PK.MU:PR6.1**

 - b With substantial guidance, demonstrate performance decorum appropriate for the audience. **PK.MU:PR6.1.B**

- 1 The personal evaluation of musical work(s) and performance(s) is informed by analysis, interpretation, and established criteria. **PK.MU:RE9.1**
