1 Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work.

A Envision/Conceptualize

- a Propose potential choices characters could make in a guided drama experience (e.g., process drama, story drama, creative drama). a. Propose potential new details to plot and story in a guided drama experience (e.g., process drama, story drama, creative drama). **TH:CR1A.1.A**

A Select
