Creating

1 Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work. TH:CR1.PK

Envision/Conceptualize

- a With prompting and support, transition between imagination and reality in dramatic play or a guided drama experience (e.g., process drama, story drama, creative drama). TH:CR1.A.PK
