

Social Emotional Competencies: Early Gr. 3-5

SELF-AWARENESS: PERSONAL QUALITIES AND/OR TRAITS SEM0.1

- 1 Distinguishes range of emotions SEM0.1.E1
- 2 Uses age-appropriate language to talk about one's feelings SEM0.1.E2
- 3 Describes physical responses to emotions SEM0.1.E3
- 4 Recognizes and discusses how emotions are linked to behavior SEM0.1.E4
- 5 Describes socially acceptable ways to express emotions SEM0.1.E5
- 6 Identifies feelings associated with having different hearing abilities SEM0.1.E6
- 7 Identifies descriptors often assigned to individuals with hearing loss, e.g. Deaf, DeafBlind, hard of hearing, limited hearing, unilateral loss, etc. SEM0.1.E7
- 8 Demonstrates positive attitude toward self as a unique person with differing hearing abilities SEM0.1.E8
- 9 Practices positive self-talk SEM0.1.E9
- 10 Discusses unique aspects of growing up as a child who is deaf or hard of hearing (growing up in a deaf, hard of hearing, or hearing family/peer group) SEM0.1.E10
- 11 Identifies needs of deaf or hard of hearing child within a family, the school, and/or the community (e.g. communication, rules, respect, behavior, participation) SEM0.1.E11
- 12 Describes personal qualities/skills possessed and interests one wants to develop SEM0.1.E12
- 13 Explains how family members, peers, school personnel and community members can be used to support school success and responsible behavior SEM0.1.E13

- 1 Uses self-monitoring to regulate emotions SEM0.2.E1
- 2 Demonstrates ways to increase positive emotions SEM0.2.E2
- 3 Uses positive self-talk for motivation SEM0.2.E3

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- 4** Makes choices about how and when to express emotions SEM0.2.E4

 - 5** Demonstrates skills for handling pressure situations (e.g. calm down, walk away, seek help, brain breaks, delay response) SEM0.2.E5

 - 6** Demonstrates an ability to express own perspective SEM0.2.E6

 - 7** Identifies personal strengths and challenges SEM0.2.E7

 - 8** Demonstrates use of coping strategies SEM0.2.E8

 - 9** Describes things that one can and cannot control SEM0.2.E9

 - 10** Explains the differences between fixed and growth mindsets SEM0.2.E10

 - 11** With prompting, identifies and practices strategies to reduce conflict SEM0.2.E11

- 1** Identifies verbal, physical, and situational cues that indicate how others may feel SEM0.3.E1

 - 2** Describes the expressed feelings and perspectives of others SEM0.3.E2

 - 3** Demonstrates respect for differences SEM0.3.E3

 - 4** Continues to expand vocabulary and responses appropriate for social situations (meanings) SEM0.3.E4

 - 5** Understands the rules of conversation SEM0.3.E5

 - 6** Explains what effective communication looks like and sounds like SEM0.3.E6

 - 7** Demonstrates appropriate communication repair strategies SEM0.3.E7
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**RELATIONSHIP
SKILLS** SEM0.4

- 1** Adapts attention getting behaviors to setting or to person (e.g. at recess versus during instruction, a friend vs. an adult) SEM0.4.E1

- 2** Explains what effective communication looks like and sounds like SEM0.4.E2

- 3** Signals to others when it is their turn to speak by asking questions, pausing, and looking or giving other cues SEM0.4.E3

- 4** Ends conversations appropriately SEM0.4.E4

- 5** Develops understanding that there are formal and informal social expectations (e.g. using a first name sign rather than Mrs. Smith [informal] while using full name when identifying in writing [formal]) SEM0.4.E5

- 6** Develops awareness that social cues may be different among various groups (e.g. family, Deaf Community, peers) SEM0.4.E6

7 Describes approaches for making and keeping friends SEM0.4.E7

8 Gives and receives compliments in a genuine manner SEM0.4.E8

9 Demonstrates good sportsmanship SEM0.4.E9

10 Demonstrates behaviors and language associated with cooperation SEM0.4.E10
